838 C Birnie family correspondence comprising entires with Imperf or Perf Penny Reds (9, two with boxed 'QUEEN/STREET' handstamp), three entires to Victoria 1856 with Embossed 6d (almost 4 margins, small fault at base), 1857 with 2d blue & defective 4d, and 1861 with 1d & fine 4d pair, plus a few scraps, condition rather mixed. 839 PS A- 1944 commercial usage of 6d Air Letter from 'KILREEL/CO DOWN' (Ulster) to "44 Staging Post/RAF/PAIFORCE" at Sharjah, chatty letter includes comment about German POWs described as "...docile & well-behaved & noone need be in the least bit nervous. They were only in NI a week when 4 escaped & they had only been caught when 3 more got out...Now I see Belgians are to be sent here for training..." Ex John Daynes.
