1934 commercial airmail cover from Sydney to Wau with KGV 2d pair, endorsed "Left Territory" in red & with good strike of the rare boxed 'UNCLAIMED/AT RABAUL' h/s, Sydney DLO re-sealing label on the flap & h/s in magenta on the face. [4d was a short-lived rate introduced in 1932, comprising 2d surface to Port Moresby (reduced to 1½d in 1933) + 2d air on the Port Moresby-Salamaua route]
