394 O **Stamp Duty:** 1866-68 Large Chalons No Watermark 1d 6d 2/6d & the rare 6/- yellow-brown (sound but trimmed perfs at base); Medium Chalons 1d (2), 6d (2), 1/- 2/- 5/- & 10/-; Small Chalons 1d (3) to 20/-, the last with 'REGISTERED/CHARTERS TOWERS' postal cds which is probably a fake; condition variable.
