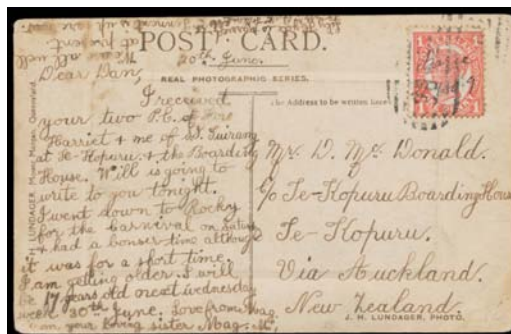

An unusually fine & attractive Queensland <i>Chalons</i> cover.	1,250
275	C	B	1870 & 1873 <i>Dodgson</i> covers to Putney 1) "Via Marseilles" with 2d pair & 6d, Rays '40' (<i>Manning</i> rated RR) of 'DALRYMPLE' (b/s); & 2) "Via Brindisi" with 3d & 6d tied by light Rays of Rockhampton; minor defects. An attractive pair. (2)	300T
