These are cross-referenced to "Pierron's Modern GB and Commonwealth Missing Colour Errors" (2008), which lists only "totally missing colours". References are made to the results for Sir Gawaine Baillie's errors that were sold at auction in Melbourne in July 2005, generally for stronger prices than were achieved in London for Tom Pierron's errors in December 2009.
