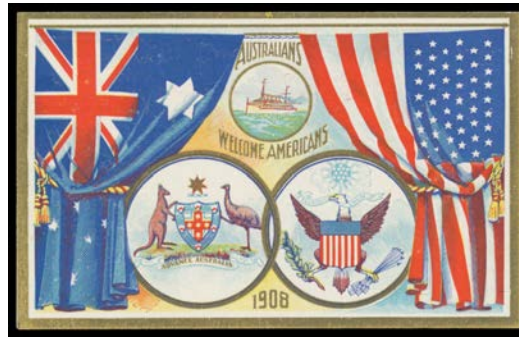

344 PS A+ 1908 Visit of the American "Great White Fleet" 1d PC16, unused. Superb! [These generic cards were printed in NSW. The relevant Queensland, South Australian, Tasmanian, or Western Australian 1d stamp was overprinted at Melbourne. The WA 1d electro with *Decapitated Swan* flaw (*Pope & Thomas's "Die 11"*) is common to this and the next two lots]

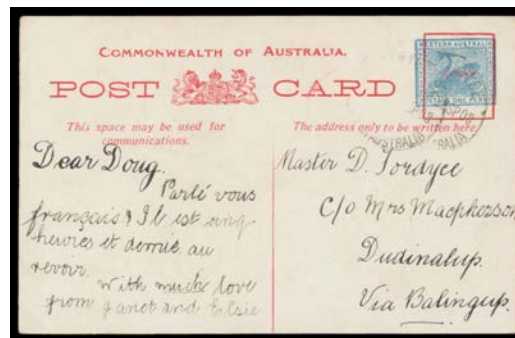

346 PS A 1908 Visit of the American "Great White Fleet" 1d PC16, to "Dudinalup/Via Balingup" with light 'COTTESLOE' cds of 22SP08 & light unframed 'BALINGUP' arrival b/s. Issued 1/9/1908: examples used in the month of issue are scarce & desirable. [The message is unusually between children, the senders practising their rudimentary French! Dudinalup is a locality near Nannup: it has never had a post office. *Hugh Freeman's* philatelic usage to the USA sold for \$862 at our auction of 23/9/2011]
