765 */**O - Wide-ranging collection on *Hagners* including two pages of Imperfs & a page of other Skilling issues many with numeral cancels including some exceptional strikes, 5kr GPO x2, 1918 Surcharges on Newspaper Stamps Perf 14x14½ mint set x2, 1924 Danish Post *setenant* blocks of 4 mint & used, 1925-29 Airs sets mint x3 & used x3, 1929 Cancer Fund corner blocks of 4 **, etc, also a duplicated post-WWII array, condition variable but many are fine to very fine, STC SKr175,000+ (= \$A25,000+). **(1000+)**
