MANUSCRIPT MARKINGS

Recorded instances of manuscript markings are listed by PSSA. However, they are "NR" (= Not Rated). Most are rare; many are unique. In Victoria, almost every manuscript cancellation in indelible pencil was applied in transit at the GPO to improperly serviced registered covers. We would not be surprised if the same is the case in South Australia. [See also Lot 2375]

2656 C B A1 **Barunga:** "Barunga" in indelible pencil on KGV 1d red x4, large registration label with poor squared-circle apparently of 'WOKURNA' (LRD; rated RRR), GPO arrival b/s of JA23/16, the address partly erased & the cover opened-out. Unrecorded in PSSA. [At this date, Barunga was an RO & probably did not have a datestamp or registration facilities]

2657 C B A1 **Berri:** "Berri" in indelible pencil on Kangaroos 2d grey pair (faults) on Shierlaw registered front. Illustrated in PSSA.

2658 C B B1 **Farina:** "Farina" in indelible pencil on KGV 1 1/2d brown x3 on Shierlaw cover, 'FARINA' h/s in violet on small provisional registration label, GPO arrival b/s of DE8/19. Not recorded in PSSA.

2659 O A- A1 **Gawler:** "Gawler" in indelible pencil on lightly cancelled Thick 'POSTAGE' 9d. Not recorded in PSSA.

2660 D A- A1+ **Hog Bay:** "Hog Bay" in indelible pencil on '2½d.' on 4d & 2½d blue. Not recorded in PSSA. PO 1860; renamed Penneshaw 18/10/1904. [Kangaroo Island]

2661 S B A1 **Lammeroo:** "Lameroo/18 12 05" (ERD) on 2d violet. Recorded in PSSA for 8 days only. RO 13/12/1905; PO -/3/1907; renamed Lameroo early-1916. Rare manuscript cancellation at a Receiving Office, in the first week of opening.

It's not unusual for residents to spell the name of their town one way, and officialdom to spell it another. Apparently even the ROK didn't accept the formal spelling with two 'M's. The 'PAID/LAMEROO' cds is of the Colonial pattern so it was almost certainly allocated well before the official name change! **NB:** it may well have been intended to upgrade the office to a PO when postal note facilities were introduced on 4/9/1906. However, *Martin Walker* notes that the upgrading actually occurred about 6 months later. Examples of the squared-circle in the RO period must be very rare.

2662 C C A1 **Lobethal:** postmaster's endorsement "Lobethal/8 1 58" at upper-left on a stained cover with defective Imperf 2d & poor numeral '49', GPO transit & Port Adelaide (all dateslugs inverted) arrival b/s. Illustrated in PSSA.

2663 C B A1 **Mingary:** "Mingary" in black pencil on KGV 1d red x4 & large registration label (damaged). There are four under-inked & illegible strikes of a squared-circle (probably Mingary). Apparently the ink supply ran out & the manuscript was applied at Mingary. Unrecorded in PSSA.

2664 S A A1 **Ovingham:** "Ovingham" in black ink on Thin 'POSTAGE' 4d. Unrecorded in PSSA.

Lot 2665

2665 C B A1 **Parilla:** "Parrillia" in indelible pencil on KGV Rough Paper 1d red only on an officially registered Shirlaw front, the mis-spelled cancellation crossed-out & corrected in a different hand to "Parilla", also endorsed - apparently in the same hand as "Parrillia" - "Def postage" & by a third person "noted [initials]". Illustrated in PSSA. A most unusual item for the collector of postmarks, registered mail, or postage due.

2666 C C A1 **Stockwell:** postmaster's endorsement "PO/Stockwell/Oct 19 58" at upper-left on a soiled cover to Prussia with Imperf Adelaide Printing 2d & London Printing 6d (both with three margins) & poor to good numeral '109' (rated R), GPO & Port Adelaide (all dateslugs inverted) transit b/s. Illustrated in PSSA. [It appears that two other stamps have been removed at the top]

**Lot 2667****2667** C A A1 **Veitch:** "Veitch" in indelible pencil on KGV 1d red x5 on registered *Shierlaw* front. Unrecorded in PSSA.
