2371	SD	Collection on <i>Hagners</i> between '1' and '311' with 159 of the 280 recorded numbers including the following all rated RRR '84' '85' '91' '127' '131' '148' '159' '161' '175' '204' '207' '208' '214' '223' '251' '264' '278' '285' & '305', those on piece with cds "ties" are '13' of 'PAYNEHAM', '15' of 'MITCHAM', '25' of 'GAWLER' (odd cds), '43' of 'GUMERACHA', '44' of 'MOUNT TORRENS', '47' of 'OAKBANK', '51' of 'MOUNT BARKER', '64' of 'CLARENDON', '70' of 'PORT-ELLIOTT' (large cds), '75' of 'YANKALILLA', '81' of 'PENWORTHAM', '88' of 'RHYNIE', '104' of 'HAMILTON' & '157' of 'EDEN VALLEY', also Receiving Offices Numeral-in-Circle '1' to '6', mostly on 2d values (many <i>Perkins Bacon</i> issues) but some are on better stamps. An excellent basis for expansion. The strikes have all been confirmed by us but some are light or good only [ <b>NB</b> : 34 of the 314 numbers have not been recorded] <b>(160+)</b>	1,500
2372	SD	- the duplicates with lots of fine to superb strikes & some highly rated but doubtful strikes, also a few poor strikes on pieces with cds, some duplication & a few better stamps. <b>(230 approx)</b>	250

2373	C	Covers comprising 1862 with '1' & 'PORT ADELAIDE' cds, 1876 with '4' & 'ALBERTON' cds, 1863 front only with '8' & 'NORWOOD' cds, 1871 with '18' & 'BRIGHTON' cds (rated RR), 1855 with '21' on 2d strip of 3 (a bit cut-into) & '[DRY] CREEK' cds, 1862 with '25' & odd 'GAWLER___' cds, 1857 with '26' but no Koorunga cds, 1857 with '30' on 2d blood-red & 'TANUNDA' cds, 1866 with '43' on badly oxidised 2d & 'GUMERACKA' cds (RRR), 1869 with '50' & 'ECHUNGA' cds, 1855 with '55' on 4-margins 2d & 'STRATHALBYN' cds in blue, 1864 with '56' & 'CURRENCY CREEK' cds (rated RRR), 1856 front only with '70' & 'PORT-ELLIOTT' cds, 1862 with '75' & 'YANKALILLA' cds (RR), 1890 1d Postal Card with superb '88' & 'RHYNIE' cds, 1891 with '114' & 'BLACK SPRINGS' cds (RR), 1863 with '151' & 'TUNGKILLO' cds, 1905 front only with '225' & superb 'MILLBROOK' squared-circle, c.1908 PPCs with '64' & '81' both used at the GPO, and 1951 philatelic cover with '26' & 'SHEA OAK LOG' cds, condition rather mixed. <b>(21 items)</b>	1,000

2374	SC	A/A- Selection comprising '19', '25', superb '30', '54' (rated R, on <i>London Printing</i> 2d with <i>Re-Entry</i> #3 on 1856 outer), '59', '61', '71' (two superb strikes on Rouletted 1/- orange pair), '86' (RR), '88' on '3-PENCE' on 4d, '94', '102' (RRR), '115' of Saddleworth (RRR), '[1]44' (R) & '[1]52' (RRR); also <b>Receiving Office</b> numeral-in-circle types '1' on piece with 'TOO-LATE' H/S, '2', '3' & superb '4' on piece; strikes are a bit mixed but most are fine to superb, some very attractive Imperf & Rouletted stamps. This group would likely improve any collection of the numerals. <b>(18 items)</b>	400

**2375** S A A1 Manuscript "30" of Tanunda, "50" of Echunga in blue pencil, & "103" of Bald Hills all on DLR 2d. All illustrated in PSSA & apparently the only recorded examples.

**2376** C B A2- 6: '6'-in-circle & bars two clear strikes on Rouletted 2d vertical strip of 3 (the last unit damaged) and unframed 'REDRUTH/("26")NO/1862/[S-A]' cds (rated RR+) - in Receiving Office period - on cover to Wales with 'ABERGAVENNY/JA19/63' arrival b/s, a bit soiled. RO early-1858; PO c.1863; closed 30/9/1905. [Copper mining]

Examples of this numeral are common because it was later used as a "killer" at the GPO. However, in the Redruth period, this is either the only recorded cover or one of two, and thus a very important "tie". PSSA records "27-11-1862" but that may be a typographical error.

**2377** C B A1 10: '10' very fine strike tying Rouletted 2d & very fine 'NORWOOD/DE30/1861=SOUTH-AUSTRALIA=' (rated RRRR; ERD), light 'KAPUNDA' arrival b/s, flap removed. Rated R. *Campbell & Pearce* noted a re-allocation from Kensington (2) to Norwood, presumably when Kensington was downgraded in 1856 to a Receiving Office. PSSA note the re-allocation under Kensington but don't list '10' under Norwood.

**2378** C A- A1 **19:** '19' very fine strike - & two lesser strikes - in blue on DLR 2d strip of 3, 21mm 'GLENELG/JY16/70/S.A' b/s also in blue (the only such strike recorded; rated RR+), to New Zealand with 'NZ/DUNEDIN/OTAGO' transit and 'WELLINGTON' arrival b/s. Scarce destination in this period.

**2379** CL (B) A1 **31:** '31' two fine to very fine strikes on Rouletted 2d pair, largely very fine 'ANGASTON/NO28/1861'=SOUTH AUSTRALIA=' cds (rated RRR) on double-rate outer, very fine GPO arrival b/s, some soiling & repaired splits along folds.

**2380** S B A1- **42:** '42' of Chain of Ponds, largely very fine strike on Imperf 2d. Rated RRR.

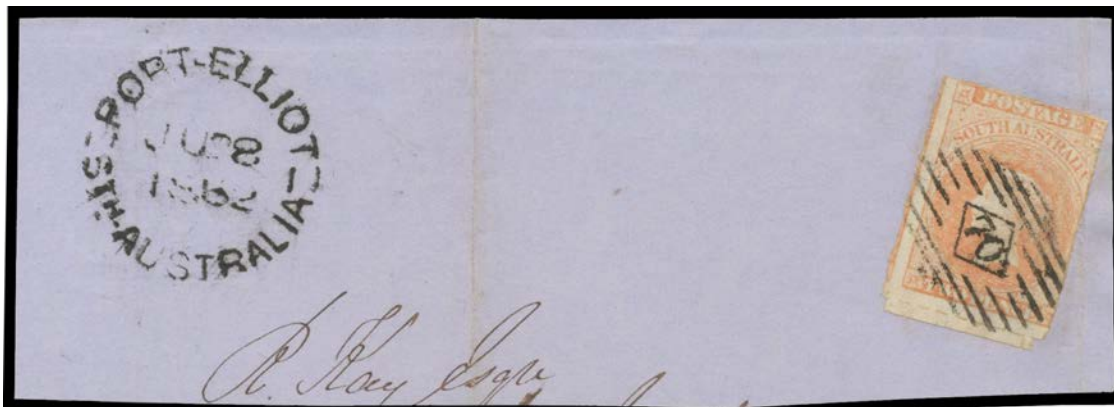

**2381** C A- A1+ **66:** '66' superb strike on London Printing 6d (cut-into) on cover to Shropshire, light but largely fine strike of the 'MORPHETT-VALE/JA10/1859'-SOUTH-AUSTRALIA' cds (rated RRRR), Adelaide transit b/s in blue, light Shropshire transit b/s of AP1/59 & fine undated 'BURLTON' arrival b/s.

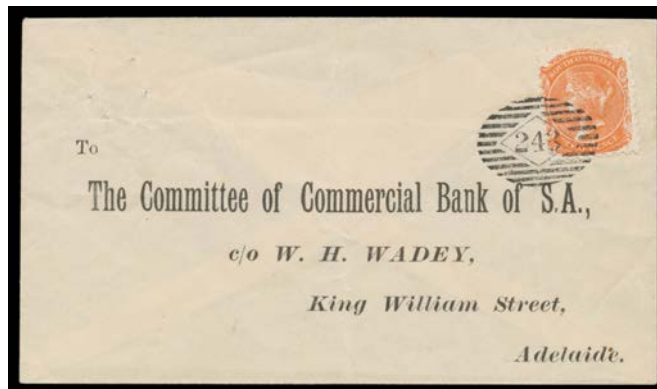
<b>2392</b>	D	A C1	<b>202:</b> '202' of Wilpena, obvious strike on <i>Perkins Bacon</i> Rouletted 2d with 'WILPENNA/JA30/65/SA' cds (B2; rated RRRRRR - the only recorded example) alongside. Rated RRR but RRRRRR for the initial allocation. An outstanding "tie". Wilpena (1) 1864; closed 1865; '202' re-allocated to Parrot's Hill. [PSSA states "No illustration available" for both markings, which must call into question the RRR rating for the numeral]	400

<b>2393</b>	S	B A2+	<b>208:</b> '208' of Paratoo, superb strike on <i>DLR</i> 2d. Rated RRR.	150

PO 1/10/1868; closed 18/12/1939. Illustrated in *PSSA*: the strike is actually a little stronger than it appears there. 250
