350 ** A B1 **1971 Aboriginal Art 25c Body Painting** horizontal pair from the right of the sheet, the second unit with the *Black Printing Partly Omitted*, unmounted. This is a **newly discovered variant** of the "Missing Black" error BW #565c-cb. In this instance, part of the background behind 'AUSTRALIA' is omitted, resulting in a significant void at the base. In addition, the facial features of the right-hand native are omitted. Finally, there are numerous white specks on the left-hand native.
