**NAURU - Postal History****Lot 681**

- 681** C A- **1927 Pflum** cover to Pennsylvania "Per Air Mail/via Sydney/& San Francisco" with rare albeit philatelic combination franking of *Rough Paper Ships* 1d strip of 3 tied by 'NAURU/21SP26/CENTRAL/PACIFIC' cds plus **United States 24c Airmail** cancelled at San Francisco, 'PHILADELPHIA PA' arrival b/s. [During the 1920s, the United States allowed their own stamps to be affixed at overseas destinations to pay the US internal air mail of 8c 16c or 24c depending on how many sectors were to be flown. Even philatelic examples from any of the Pacific Islands are seldom seen and examples from Nauru are rare]
