

REVENUES: c.1940 'TERRITORY OF PAPUA/POSTAL NOTE' with Five-Digit Serial Numbers in Black & *John Ash Imprint* at the Base 10/-, double-circle 'POST OFFICE/25/SEP/1941/PORT MORESBY, PAPUA' cds & straight-line 'PORT MORESBY' h/s both in violet, 'PAID/3.11.41' perfin (with a couple of broken pins) & two tringular punches, unusually fine. Rare. [Payable to *Golden Casket* at Brisbane. Postal Notes were a common method of purchasing sweepstake tickets through the post. The exceptional collection of Australian Postal Notes formed by the American *Jack Harwood* contained only three Papuan examples, two of which had significant faults, and no 10/-]
