759 * A/B **1860-69 Second Roulettes** 2d bright vermillion SG 26 marginal horizontal strip of 5 from the right of the sheet, some minor oxidation, large-part o.g., Cat £600++ A rare multiple.

760 F A/B - 2d bright vermillion horizontal pair *Imperf Between* SG 26a, deep shade, small scissor-cut into the base of the first unit, neat Adelaide cds of 67/JU28, Cat £650. Most of the surviving pairs have significant faults. [This pair has traces of roulettes at the top & base but has essentially been cut from the sheet to preserve the design. It may actually be *Imperf Vertically* (as distinct from "between")]
