1923 Plane Crash Simpson & Bell (Tweed Heads) *real photo* "Accident to G-AUBL 23.1.1923" (Gawking On-Lookers, the Plane Literally Split in Half), faint bend, unused. *Ex Coo-ee Picture Library.* [This incident took place at Greenmount & was caused by the pilot swerving to avoid children who ran across his path. The pilot, *Edgar Wikner Percival*, served in the Middle East with the *AIF* & was accepted into the *Royal Flying Corps*. In 1919 he established a successful aviation business at Richmond (NSW) & later became a highly respected aircraft designer]
