1174 Ω*O PROVINCES - COMMUNIST: Huge duplicated array in four Hagner albums, one of Taiwan as a Province of China, mostly common stamps but with many of significant catalogue value, lots of unused & used multiples; also a similar array from Manchukuo including 1946 Bo Tsing Locals; generally fine to very fine. Inspection a must: if even some of the highly catalogued stamps are genuine, our estimate will prove to be extremely conservative. (1000s) 2,000
