[<i>Major Fuhrman</i> was Private Secretary to Australian Prime Minister <i>Billy Hughes</i> , then to former PM <i>Sir Joseph Cook</i> as High Commisioner in London. In that capacity he attended numerous <i>League of Nations</i> meetings in Geneva. In 1948 he was <i>Chargé d'Affaires</i> in Nanking]	100
