1360	**	A	1996 Health (Road Safety) (Teddy Bear) M/S as SG MS2002 but from the original printing with the <i>Teddy Bear & Baby Facing Forwards</i> and 'SC 439' at upper-left unmounted, <i>Michel Cat</i> €12,000. Unlisted by <i>Campbell Paterson</i> . [With the <i>Joh Enschedé</i> folder in which it was supplied by the printers; and a normal M/S for comparison] <i>Gibbons</i> , in a rather disingenuous footnote, state "There is no evidence to link these miniature sheets with New Zealand!!" which sounds like <i>NZ Post</i> "spin". According to our Dutch sources, the original M/Ss had been distributed by the printers, <i>Enschedé</i> in the Netherlands, to their staff before a recall was announced. Examples sold in the <i>Prestige</i> auctions of 9.2.2008 & 30.3.2012 for \$2415 & \$1840 respectively]	1,800
