SHIPWRECK COINS**Lot 216****216**

DUNBAR: 1857 Hanks & Lloyd 1d token Gray #98 with marine encrustation. Wrecked on the South Head of Sydney Harbour, August 1857, carrying a quantity of freshly minted *Hanks & Lloyd* tokens, Sydney's worst maritime disaster with only one survivor from 125 passengers and crew.

'GILT DRAGON': Spain, c.1652 8 Reales, stated by vendor to be ex VOC *Gilt Dragon* (Vergulde Draeck), owned by the *Dutch East India Company* and wrecked off the coast of WA in 1656.

**Lot 218****218**

'RAPID': Peru, Charles IV, 1790 8 Reales, Lima mint, *mm*. 'ME', assayer 'IJ' with WA Museum certificate, VG. An American China trader wrecked off Ningaloo Reef WA in 1811.

**Lot 219****219**

'ZUYTDORP': Zeeland (Netherlands), 1711 silver 6 Stuivers (1 Hoedjesschelling), *mm* (Castle) Middelburg mint, aVG, WA museum certificate. The Zuytdorp (also Zuiddorp) missing on route to Batavia in 1711, found wrecked north of Kalbarri, WA in 1964.
