312 L B - *Amalgamated Wireless* letterhead to prominent collector *Alec Rosenblum* with typed 'LORD HOWE ISLAND/6th Sept 1930/Herewith please find 5/- worth Sturt stamps, as requested per Radio of 3rd inst', signed "SFenton" & with a light but legible strike of the oval 'RADIO STATION/6SEP1930/LORD HOWE ISLAND' datestamp. [While it is not specifically stated that the stamps bore the manuscript endorsement, the request was made after people in Australia first became aware of the existence of the provisionals. "5/- worth" = 30 stamps]
