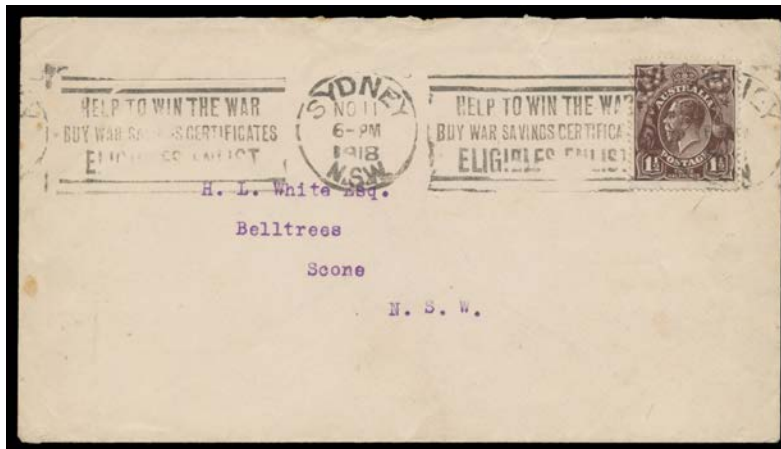

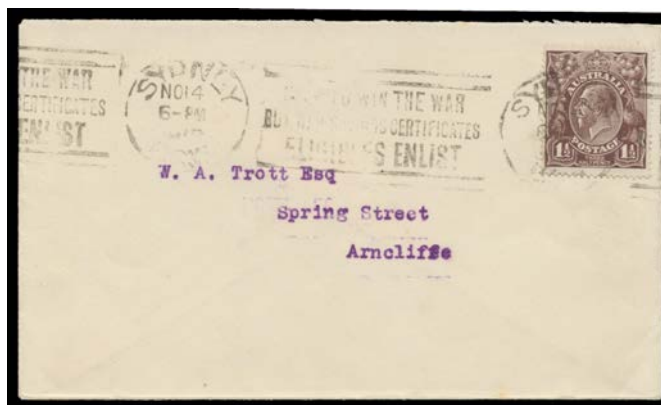
KING GEORGE V HEADS - Single Watermark

84	C	A	ONE PENNY RED COMB PERF SMOOTH PAPER: Pair with the left-hand unit <i>Bisected Diagonally</i> tied to an apparently commercial cover by Melbourne machine cancellation of 2DE18. [The ½d War Tax was introduced on 28.10.1918. No bisects were authorised but many people used this expedient]	150

167	C	A-	PENNY-HALFPENNY BLACK-BROWN: 1½d tied to cover to <i>HL White</i> by Sydney '.../ELIGIBLES ENLIST' slogan cancel of NO11/1918 (<i>Armistice Day</i>) being three days prior to the official issue of this stamp in NSW. [The official First Day of Issue was 9.11.1918, in Melbourne only. Arthur's unique First Day Cover sold for \$7735. <i>HL White</i> was a prominent collector, for whom Sydney dealer <i>Fred Hagen</i> supplied new issues and First Day Covers]	750
