<b>986</b>	**	A- B1	<b>1930 Aeroplane Overprints</b> Harrison Printings 1/- sepia & olive as SG 117 but with the <i>Overprint in Dark Carmine</i> and additionally with ' <i>AIR MAIL</i> ' Variety, the gum a little tropicalised as usual & a minor gum blemish but unmounted. Unlisted by <i>Gibbons</i> . <i>Chris Ceremuga Certificate</i> (2002) states "only the small first part of the printing received overprints in the dark carmine colour...The variety occurred only on Position 11...and was later corrected". [Better centred than <i>Peter Troy's</i> very similar example that sold at the <i>Prestige</i> auction of 28/7/2009 for \$1610]	750
