

PRISONERS OF WAR CAMPS - Federal Capital Territory

Molonglo Defence Camp was renamed Molonglo Concentration Camp 19/6/1918; closed 7/6/1919. The camp was purpose-built in anticipation of the arrival of 5000 civilians from China & East Africa. The war ended before they arrived & the camp was used for only a small number of internees who were transferred from Bourke.
