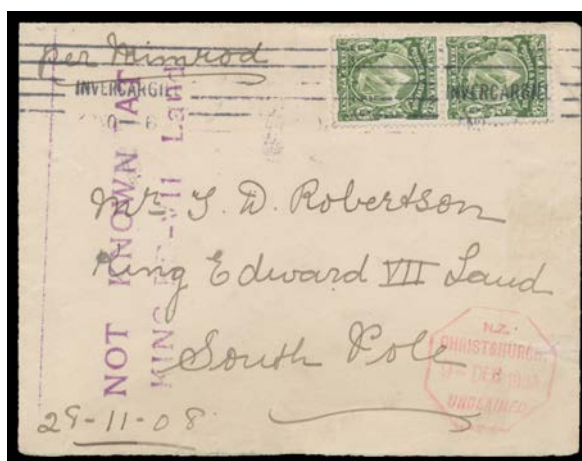

534	C/CL		<b>AUSTRALIAN:</b> Box of mostly philatelic covers from a New Zealander who was a member of ANARE in the 1950s including 1954 registered covers x4 signed on the reverse by expeditioners, FDCs from Bases including 1955 long cover for 3½d ANARE with cds & boxed cachets of Heard Mawson & Macquarie, 1957 cover & Letter Card endorsed "First Flight/Mawson-Davis" (not listed in the AAMC), at least two very scarce commercial airmail covers to New Zealand & a rare "internal" OHMS cover from Mawson to Davis, 1954 combination covers with Madagascar stamps tied by 'ARCHIPEL KERGUELEN/MADAGASCAR' cds & Australian 3½d tied by 'MAWSON' cds; also some Russian & American covers from the same source.
