594		C/CO	<b>IVORY COAST:</b> Mostly WWII airmail covers the majority to France including a variety of rates & routes, many with censor labels &/or handstamps, includes 1939 (July) underpaid to the USA, 1939 (Nov) from France, 1940 to France with 'RETOUR A L'ENVOYEUR/RELATIONS POSTALES/INTERROMPUES' h/s, 1942 to Gold Coast via Dahomey & Togo, a brown-paper packet registered with complete 'CROIX-ROUGE FRANCAISE/COMITE LOCAL DE LA COTE D'IVOIRE' address label (205x135mm) with 235fr postage on the reverse opened by French & German censors (faults, but a remarkable item), some with <i>jusqu'a</i> markings, condition variable. <b>(39)</b>	350
595	C	A-	<b>NEW CALEDONIA:</b> 1931 apparently commercial cover flown internally by <i>Victor Roffey</i> with 5c Pictorial & '90' on 75c overprint each bearing private 'AVION' h/s & tied by Nouméa '2-5/31' cds, 'KONE' transit & 'VOH' arrival b/s, minor defects. In November he flew his Gypsy Moth 'The Golden Eagle' from Ouaco, New Caledonia to Queensland, a flight that had originally been planned for August that year.	300
