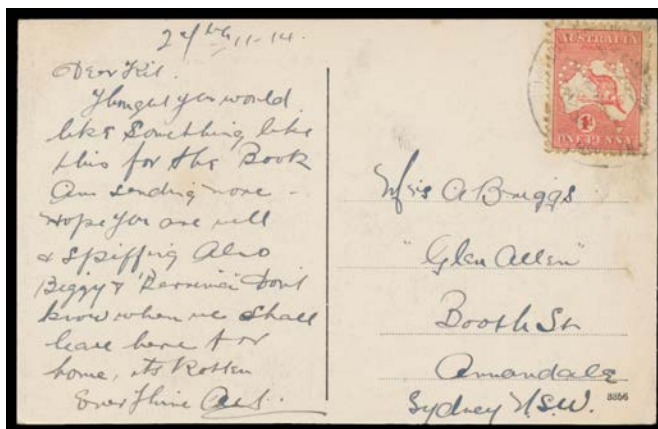


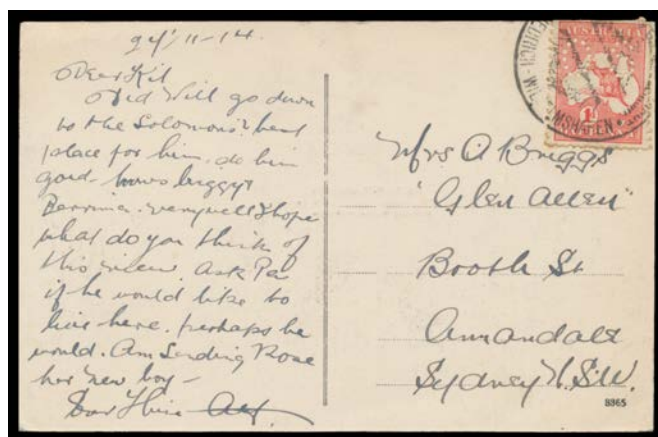

- 766** C B - 1914 PPC ("RPD Prinz Waldemar in Friedr Wilhelmshafen") with message headed "24th 11 14", to Sydney with 1d Roo punctured 'OS' tied by a light but discernible strike of the defaced 'KAISERLICHES BEZIRKSGERICHT/[eagle]/FRIEDRICH-WILHELMSHAFEN' court seal (Powell #19; rated F), minor blemishes. [The message states "...Don't know when we shall leave here for home, it's Rotten". This & the next two lots were recently discovered in a collection of postcards. They have never before been on the market]
