1238 C A/A- *South Australian Railways* selection of better views comprising "Adelaide Railway Station", "Railway Station Mount Lofty", "Assembly Platform, Adelaide Station" (two different), "Train in Mt Lofty Ranges", "In the Mt Lofty Ranges", and "Suburban Train", three with the stamps removed, fine used. (7)

1239 C A/B Adelaide & Environs group noted Bowling Green, Exhibition Building (1903 intermediate size), Hindley Street shops, Melbourne Express Train, Semaphore 'Town Hall & Signalling Station' with train at platform & Mount Lofty 1905 'Motor Car & Passengers in Snow' all postally used the majority with South Australian squared circle cancels, also larger group of glamour & artist types again mostly with SA cancels including 'PT DARWIN', a few minor blemishes but generally fine.
