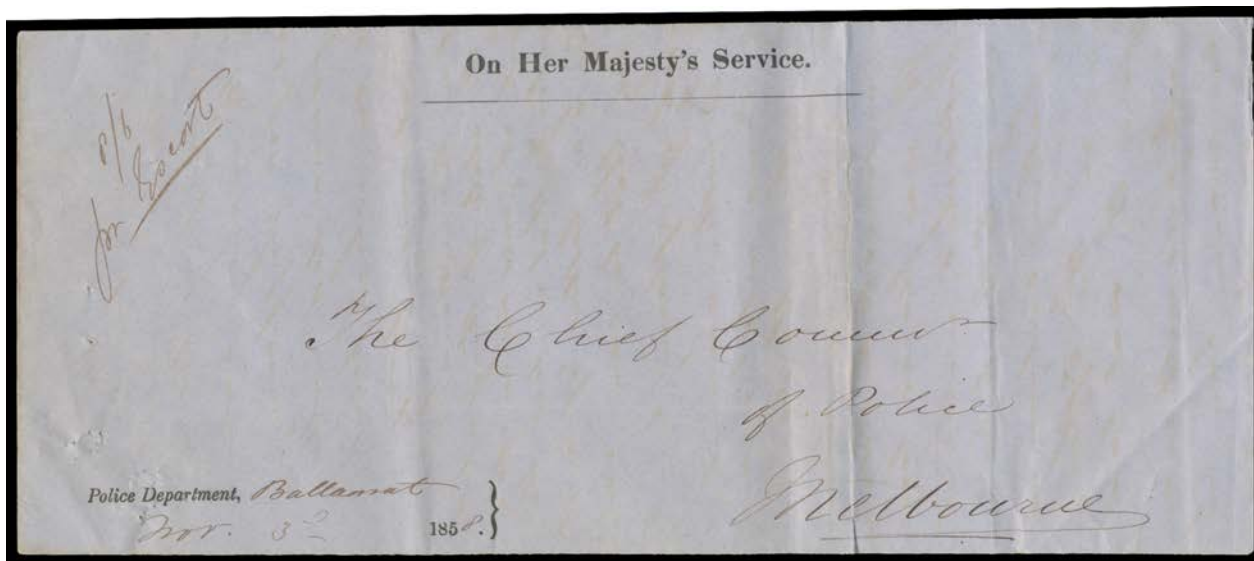

Nothing to look at but very rare.
