468	PS	A+	WESTERN AUSTRALIA - PERTH: 1939 (Sep 8) usage of KGV I 2d Envelope uprated with 4d Koala paying 3d foreign rate to Austria + 3d registration, first-type fancy label with small 'OPENED BY/CENSOR' (39x10mm) in "pink" (Little #L5-1a) tied by 'SOUTH PERTH/11SE39/WA' cds, largely superb strike of the boxed 'UNDELIVERABLE/RETURN TO SENDER' cachet in blue. A truly significant item, in superb condition. <i>Haynes & Pope</i> state only four examples of the small label have been recorded. <i>Little</i> identifies a sub-type in "pink", of which only one example has been recorded. That is this item but <i>Little</i> mistakenly listed the date of posting rather than the date of censorship. That is also an issue with his ERD for the second-type label, which he lists as used from 8.8.1939. However, again that is the date of posting, the item being held for 3 weeks before being censored, censorship being instituted only from 1.9.1939.	500 ^T
