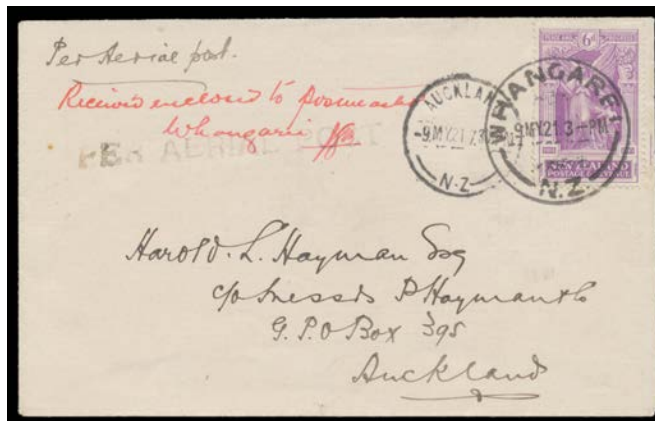

311	CL	B	1935 long cover airmail to Capetown with Kangaroos CofA Wmk 5/-, KGV 5d and Jubilee 2d (rounded corner) tied Sydney '2-JY35' cds paying 2/10d first ½oz plus 2/9d second ½oz rate for carriage by QANTAS / IAL to Egypt with '12JL35/RECD PAR/AVION/ALEXANDRIE' transit b/s and Imperial Flying Boat service to South Africa, minor fold not affecting stamps.	300 <sup>T</sup>

1219	C	A	1921 (May 9) Whangarei-Auckland flight NZAMC #28b with Victory 6d tied by Whangarei cds, 'PER AERIAL MAIL' h/s in black, endorsed "Received enclosed to postmaster/Whangarei" in rosine, Cat \$1200. <b>36 items carried.</b> [Superior to <i>Jim Stapleton's</i> similar cover that sold at the <i>Prestige</i> auction of 18.11.2006 for \$1207]	600

### PAPUA - Postal History

1256	CL	B	<b>AEROPHILATELY:</b> 1935 (Sep 27) Port Moresby-Darwin AAMC #P90 with 2d Bird & 6d Air Mail manuscript cancelled "A11-1/Port Moresby/28-9-35/[signature]" overstruck with 'DARU/ 28SE35/PAPUA' cds, Darwin b/s of 27NO35, vertical fold & minor blemishes. An enigma. [The AAMC states <i>Hempel</i> departed Moresby 27/9/1935 but this cover suggests he left a day later. Why two months to reach Darwin?]	400
