**TASMANIA - Postal History****Lot 464**

- 464** CO (B) **1871** large piece (200x143mm) from a **registered parcel** to Kent with remarkable Three-Issue franking (faults) of VDL Imperf 4d & Perf 10 1d x2 and 'TASMANIA' Imperf 6d & 1/- (cut-to-shape) all tied by BN '63' of New Norfolk, private '**BOURNBANK/Parish of Wellington**' h/s & 'N NORFOLK/22 4 71' postmaster's provisional h/s, sloping '**TOO-LATE**' h/s applied at Hobart, a few repaired edge-tears & parts of the address label removed with the registration ribbon. Endorsed "Printed Book with Photographs..." & signed "Molesworth Jeffery" which permitted mailing at the concessional rate for a "book packet" + 6d registration. **Only six items recorded bearing the 6d registration rate** that applied between 1871 & 1880. *Ex Randall Askeland, Patrick Reid & David McNamee.*
