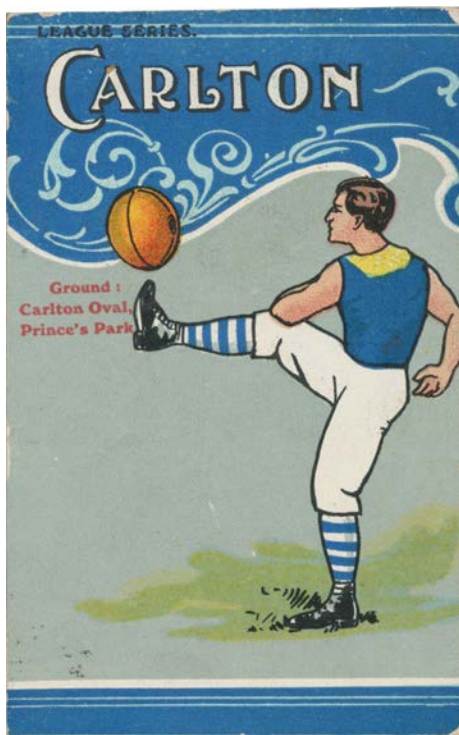

- **JAMES HIRD:** *James Albert Hird* is one of the most decorated footballers of all time. He won the 1996 *Brownlow Medal*, the club's Best & Fairest Award five times, and was five times named as an All-Australian player. He is a member of the *Australian Football Hall of Fame*. This and the next nine lots are jumpers worn by *Hird* during his illustrious playing career.

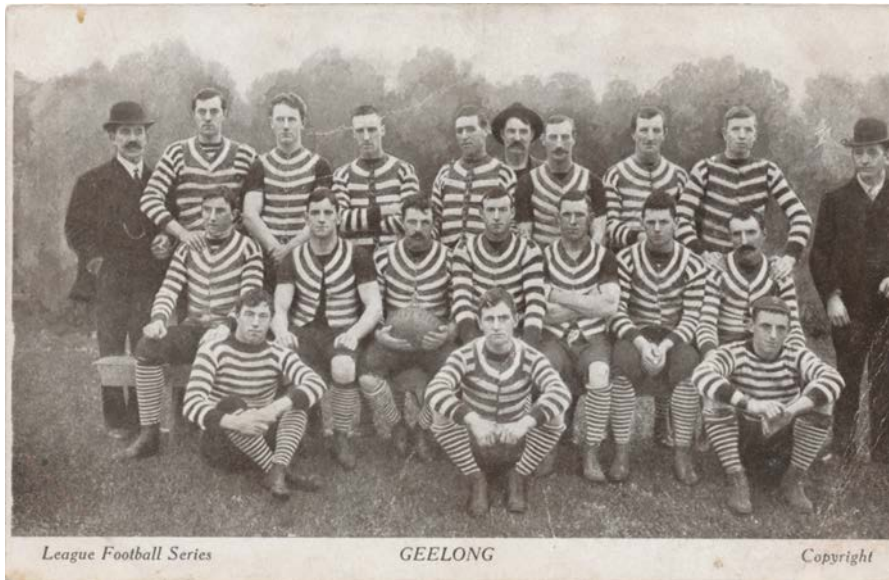

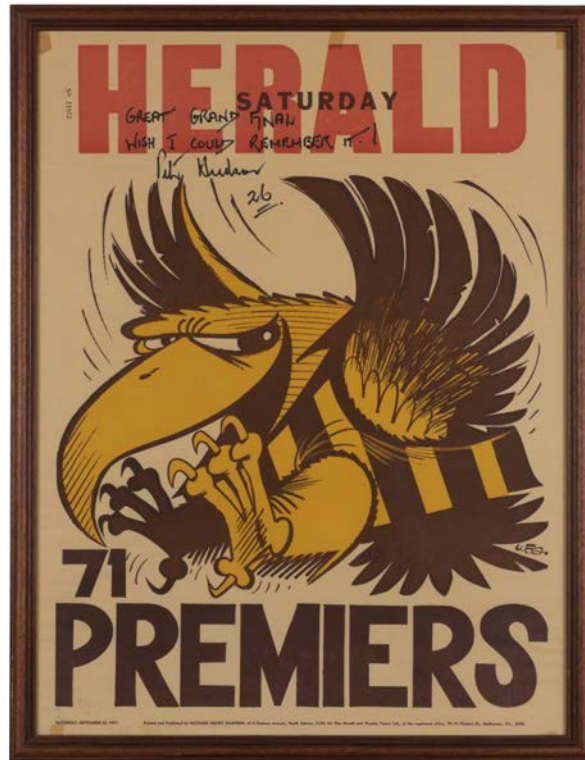

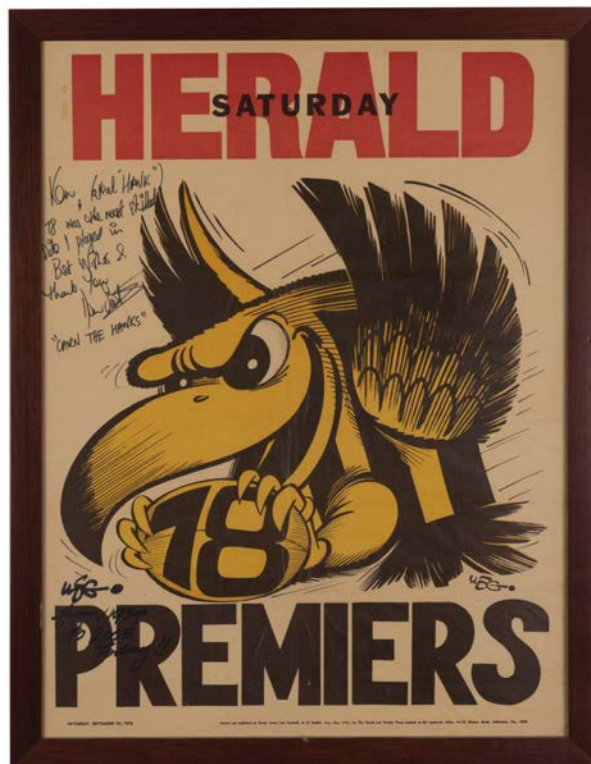
