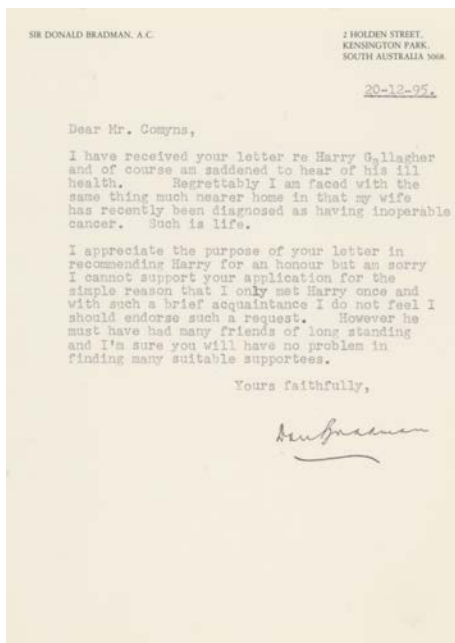

Whereas *We have thought fit to nominate and appoint you to be an Ordinary Officer of the Civil Division of Our said Most Excellent Order of the British Empire.*

We do *by these presents grant unto you the Dignity of an Ordinary Officer of Our said Order and hereby authorise you to have hold and enjoy the said Dignity and Rank of an Ordinary Officer of Our aforesaid Order together with all and singular the privileges thereunto belonging or appertaining.*

Given *at Our Court at Saint James's under Our Sign Manual and the Seal of Our said Order this Third day of June 1972 in the Twenty-first year of Our Reign.*

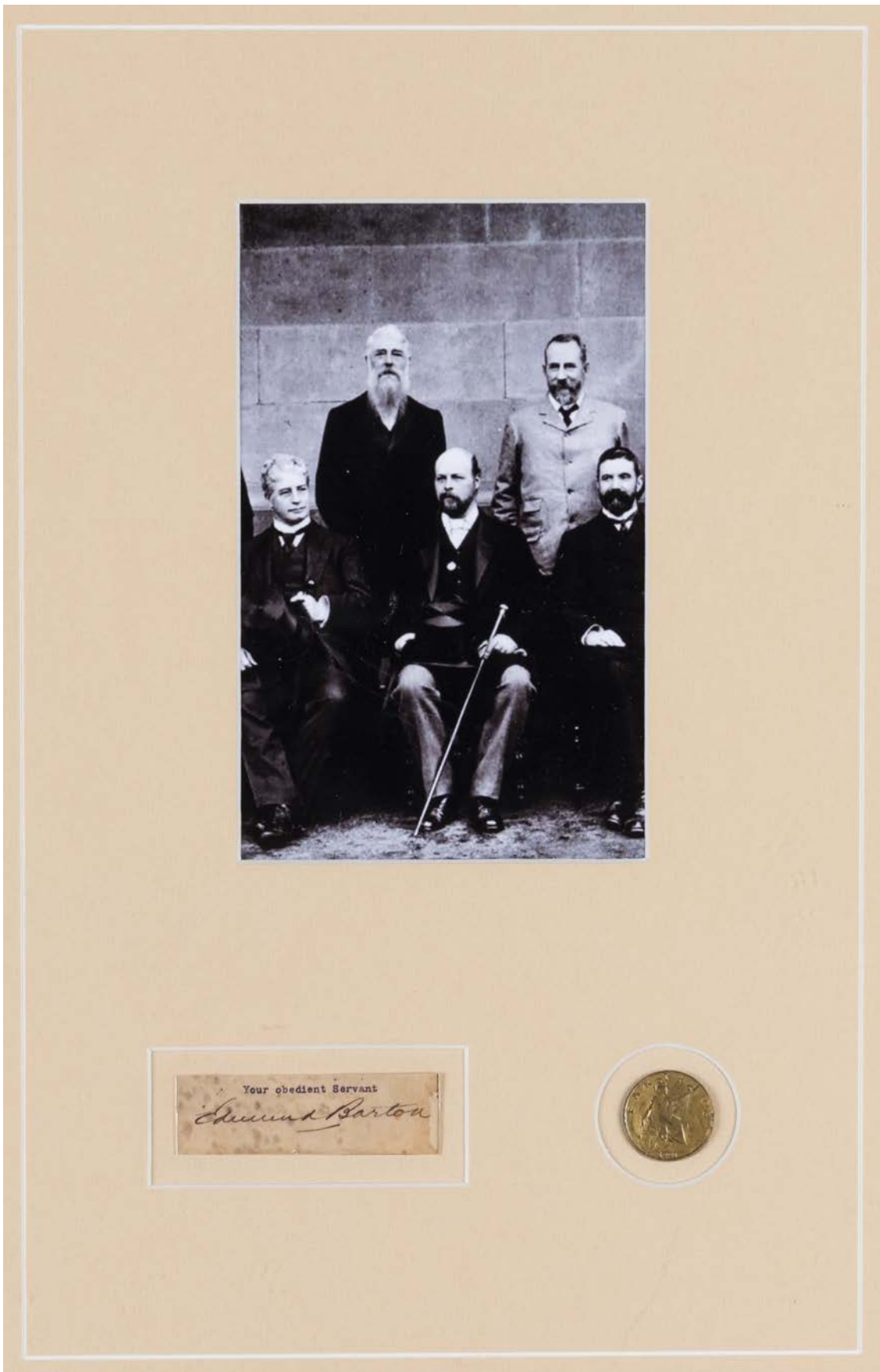

 Her time for the 2500 miles was 19hr. 7min.
 Mrs Putnam also won the distance flight record for women.
 The previous record of 2000 miles was held by Miss Ruth Nichols, who flew from Oakland (California) to Louisville (Kentucky) last year.
 Mrs Putnam was nearly mobbed on her arrival by the crowd, whose anxiety had been increased by the fact that she was reported only once during the entire trip.
 "It was a beautiful trip," she said.
 "If I had had the weather I had on my first attempt I would have broken the record."
 On her first attempt recently she was halted at Columbus through engine trouble.
 Mrs Putnam flew mainly at a height of 10,000ft. She followed the air lines, but "cut the corners" a bit.

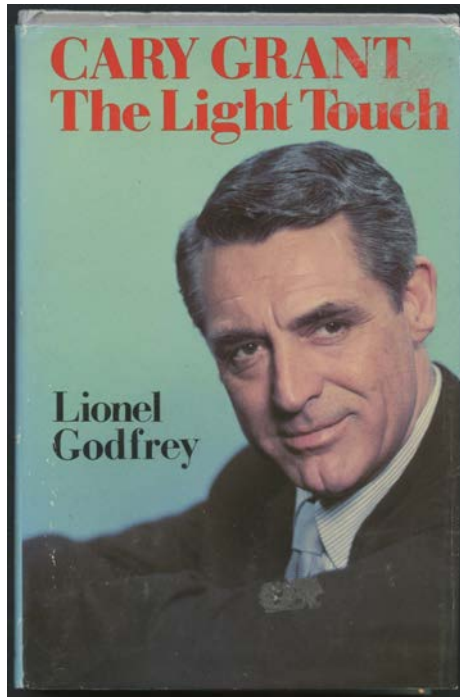
