896 E A **1911-31 Admirals 3c Reversed Image** oversize printer's sample by the German printers *Herbst u Illig* complete sheet of 25 "plate proofs" in blue-green on thick surfaced wove paper. Rare as a complete sheet: the exceptional "*Brigham*" Collection had only a block of 9 described as "possibly unique". The so-called "*Eckerlin* essays" were produced in 1928 to demonstrate the company's rotary intaglio process, stated to be faster & cheaper than printing from engraved steel plates. [*Dr Eckerlin* was a director of *Herbst u Illig*]
