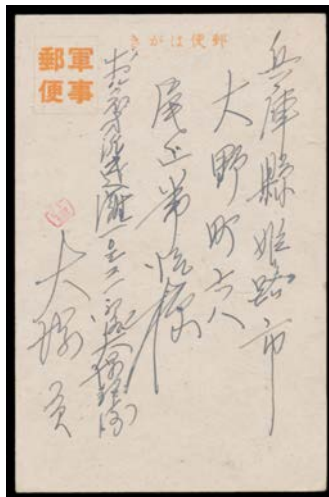

1125	C	C	- 1944 stampless cover from England to a POW at "Borneo Camps" c/- the <i>Red Cross</i> in Tokyo with large Japanese cachet that translates as 'Borneo POW Camp/Censored' in violet & censor's chop in red, some staining. Rare, and a remarkable survivor.	1,500 <sup>T</sup>
1126	**	A- C1	- 1947 Cypher Overprints \$5 vertical strip of 4, the third unit with Lower Bar Broken at Right SG 349a [R8/3], very minor toning as is often seen on this issue, unmounted, Cat £470+.	200
