See <i>Gibbons'</i> footnote. Unlisted by <i>Campbell Paterson</i> . [The design caused an outcry because the baby should have been facing the rear of the car to comply with safety regulations. The stamps were immediately withdrawn & redesigned. However, some were released "in error". According to our sources, the original M/Ss had been inadvertently distributed by the printers, <i>Enschede</i> in the Netherlands, to their staff after the recall was announced. Examples sold at the <i>Prestige</i> auctions of 9.2.2008 & 30.3.2012 for \$2415 & \$1840 respectively]	1,500 ^T
