**1012** PS A **1913** social usage of 1d Postal Card to Victoria with largely very fine strike of the Dutch ' \* VAN LINSCHOTEN \* ' ship's cachet in violet, Brisbane machine b/s of 5FEB13, unusually fine for these cards. Rare shipboard usage.

**1013** C A- **1938** KPM Dutch Shipping Line envelope airmail to Holland endorsed "Australia-France-Holland" with "Capt Kramer s/s Tasman" return address and Jubilee 2d, 8d & 1/- tied 'PORT MORESBY/PAPUA' cds, Townsville Qld transit b/s then carried by *Qantas/Imperial* service, re-directed on arrival with 'GENNEP/12X15/1938' cds on face, closed tear on back flap. Lovely three-colour franking paying 1/9d rate + 1d late fee.

1014 CL B **1939** (Jan 12) linen-lined cover with 'BIOLOGICAL EXPLORATIONS/THE AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY/...' imprint at U/L, airmail to New York endorsed "Australia-England", scarce franking of Pictorials 1/- strip of 3 & 1d, the last inadvertently tied by *jusqu'a* bars h/s of London, opened-out & a little soiled. [The rate was 1/7d + 1/6d for the second ½oz]
