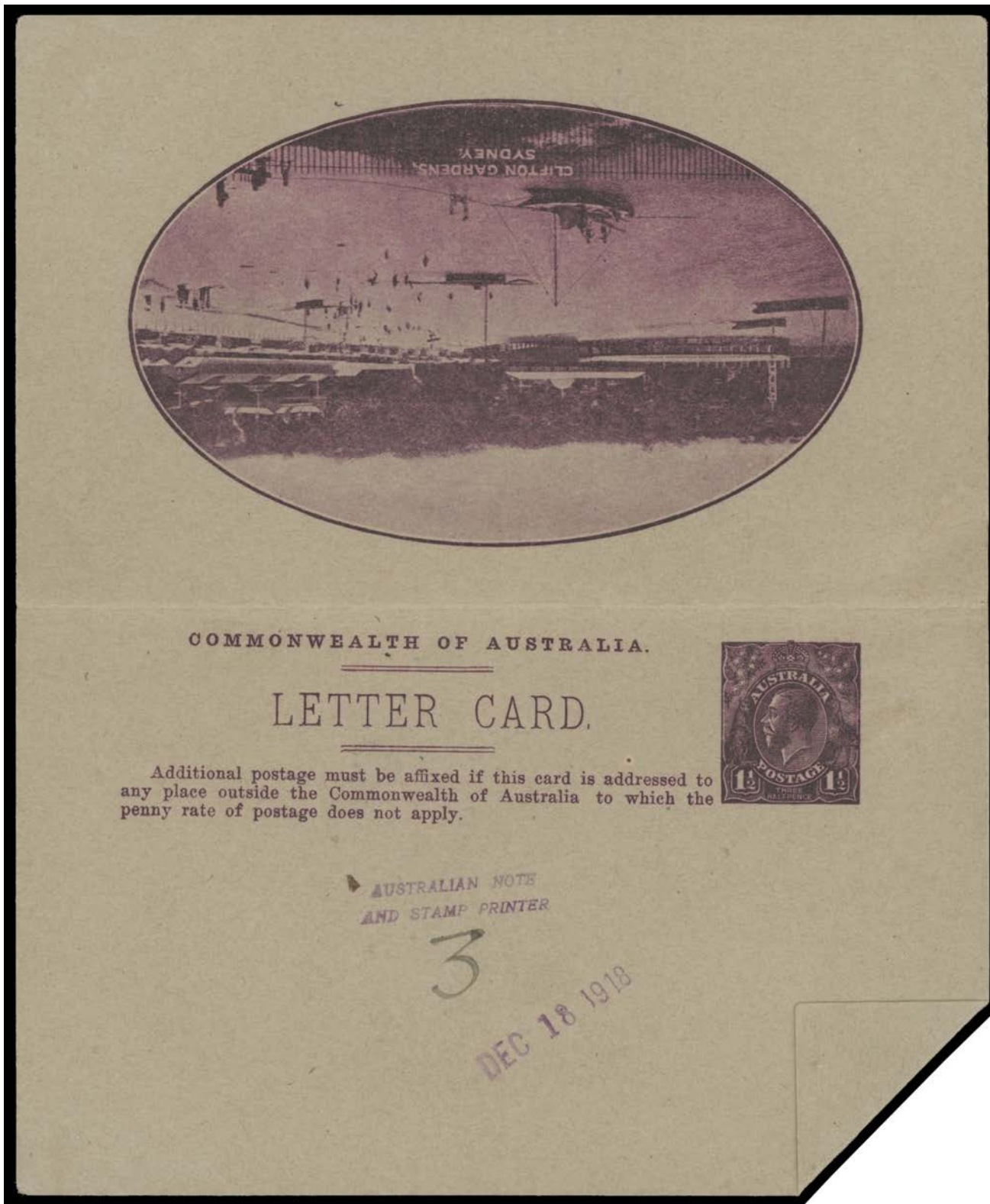

**LETTER CARDS - 1918 KGV Sideface 1½d in Various Colours**

2204	PS	A	<p><b>IMPERFORATE PROOF ACSC #LC41P(1)B:</b> 'CLIFTON GARDENS/SYDNEY' (sailing boats) in deep red-purple on ungummed uniform grey stock with one corner folded back to reveal the inside stock, 'AUSTRALIAN NOTE/AND STAMP PRINTER/("3")' cachet &amp; 'DEC 18 1918' handstamp both in violet on the address panel, Cat \$10,000. [The admonition remained unchanged, inadvertently referring to the 'penny rate of postage', which was continued on the issued cards!]</p> <p>'CLIFTON GARDENS' exists only in this format, making it <b>the rarest of all the views</b>: only one other example - a similar proof numbered "2" - is recorded.</p>	7,500

2215	PS	A	<b>SURFACED GREY STOCK (OFF-WHITE/PALE GREY WITHIN) PERF 10 ACSC #LC43:</b> 'CARTING-FAR NORTH' (camel train) in grey-brown, to New Caledonia with ½d green tied by Sydney machine cancel of DE8/1920, 'NSW/T/20' h/s but the fee apparently not collected, 'NOUMEA' arrival b/s, Cat \$150. [The foreign letter rate was 3d from 1.10.1920]	100
2216	PS	A	- 'GIBBERABONG CREEK NSW' in brown-purple, unused, Cat \$300.	150
2217	PS	A	- 'GPO HOBART' in brown-purple, unused, Cat \$300.	150
