LETTER CARDS - 1924 'THREE/HALFPENCE' Surcharges

After rushing out the 1½d green cards, Harrison turned his attention to surcharging the residual stock of 2d cards. It is estimated that only forty 2d orange cards - across both stocks & perms - were overprinted. Remarkably five of those are known to have survived.
