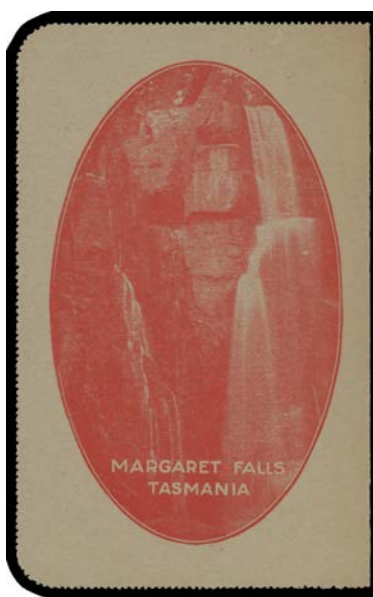
These issues appeared in Perf 12½ only. Harrison had several times requested that the views be entirely discontinued. His objection was aesthetic rather than technical but, to underline his point, he allowed some scenes to deteriorate dramatically. Many of the plates wore to the point where views were almost unidentifiable. Several others developed major plate cracks. Eventually Harrison got his way, and production of scenic cards was discontinued in 1925.

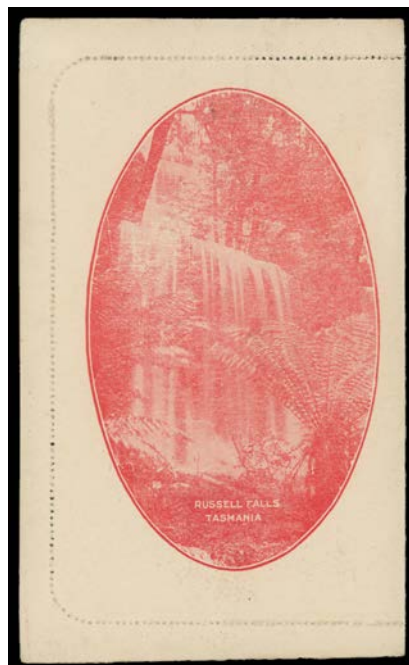
