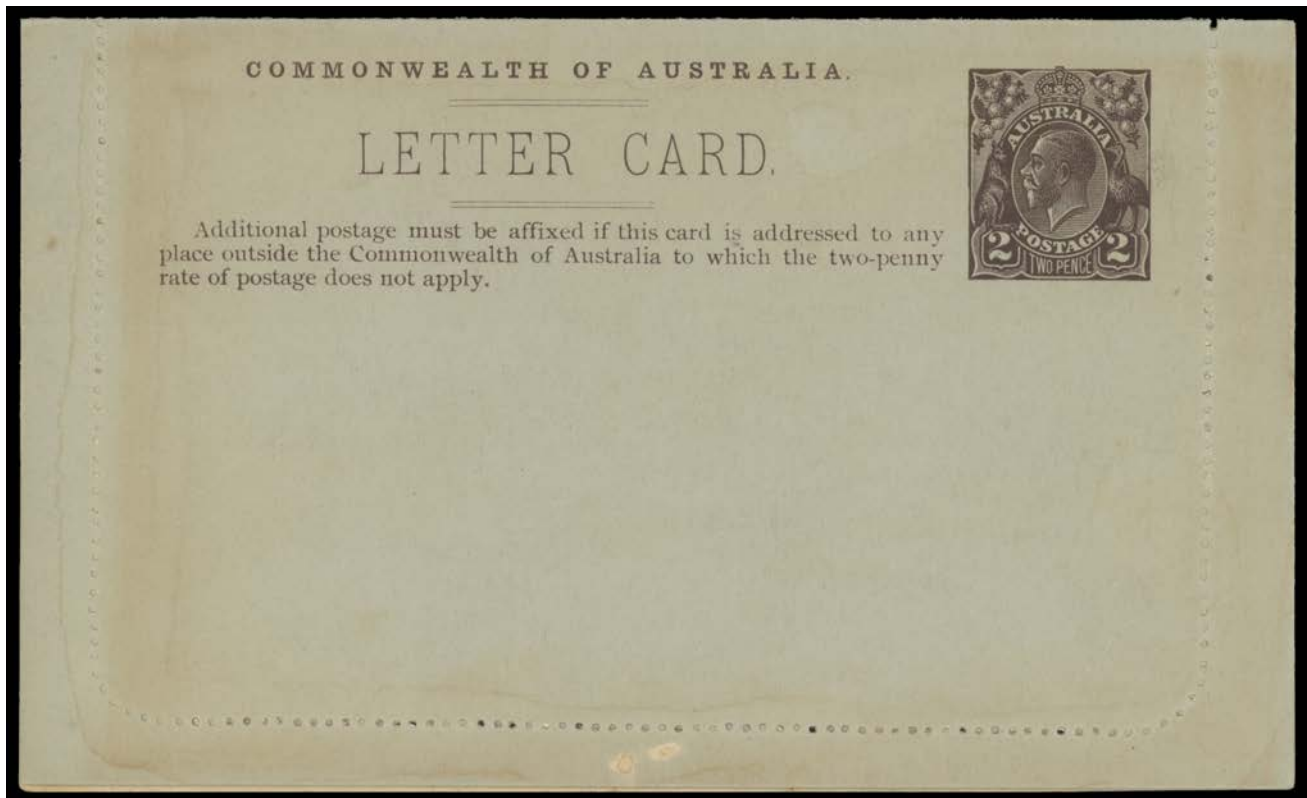

**LETTER CARDS - 1920 KGV Sideface 2d Orange**

On 1.10.1920, the domestic letter rate was increased to 2d. The attractive white stock was relatively expensive & resulted in a fee of 1d per card being added to the 2d face value. This caused a significant drop in usage. The cheaper grey stock allowed a reduction in cost to 7½d per three cards, & then to 2½d each, which did result in improved sales.

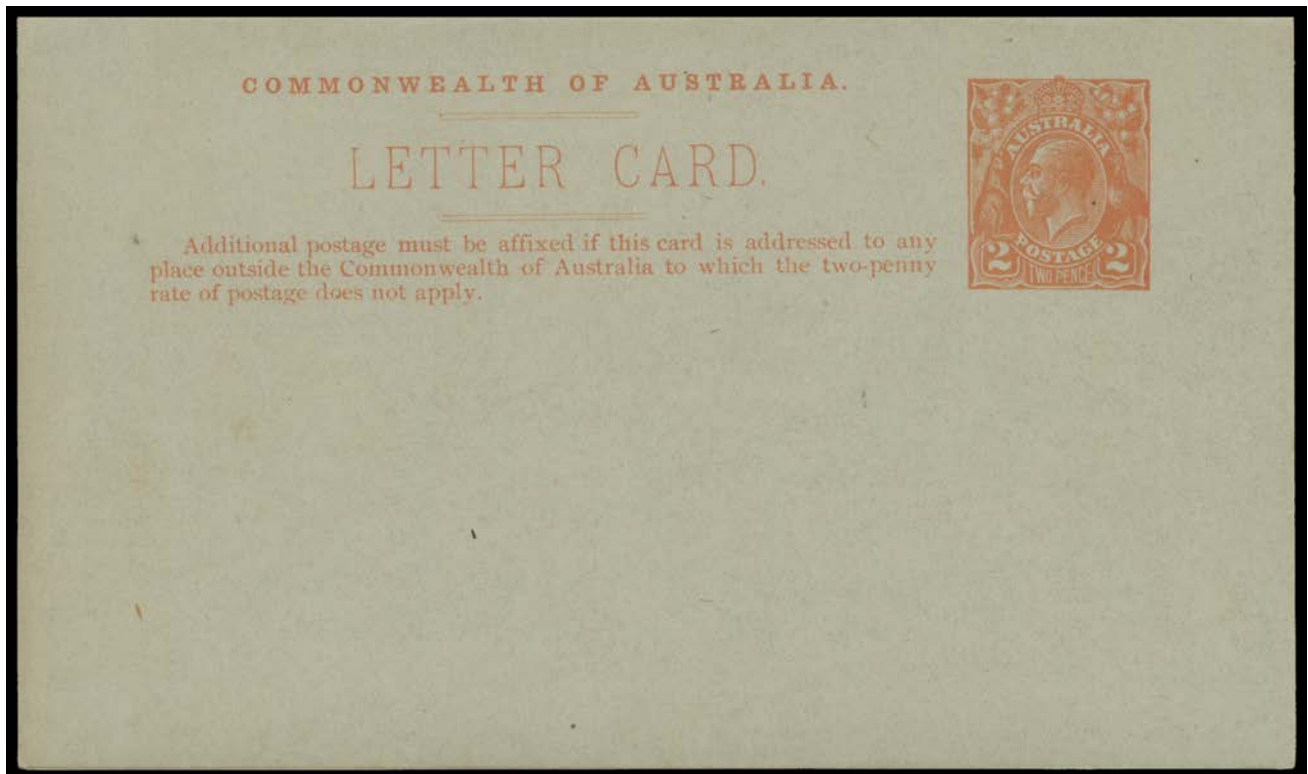

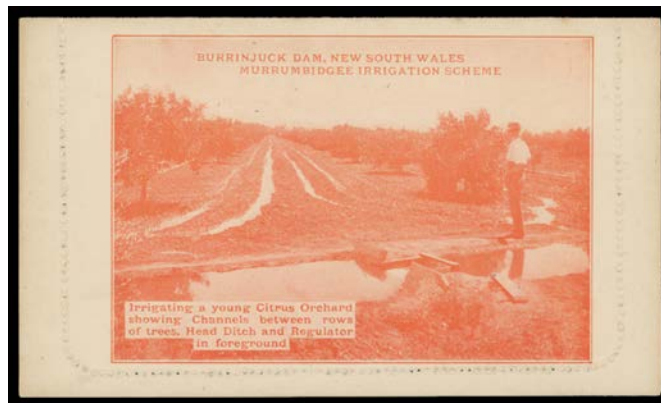

[The ACSC states only one unused example - with the margins removed - & two used examples, all with this view, are recorded. That makes this one of the very rarest of the issued cards]
