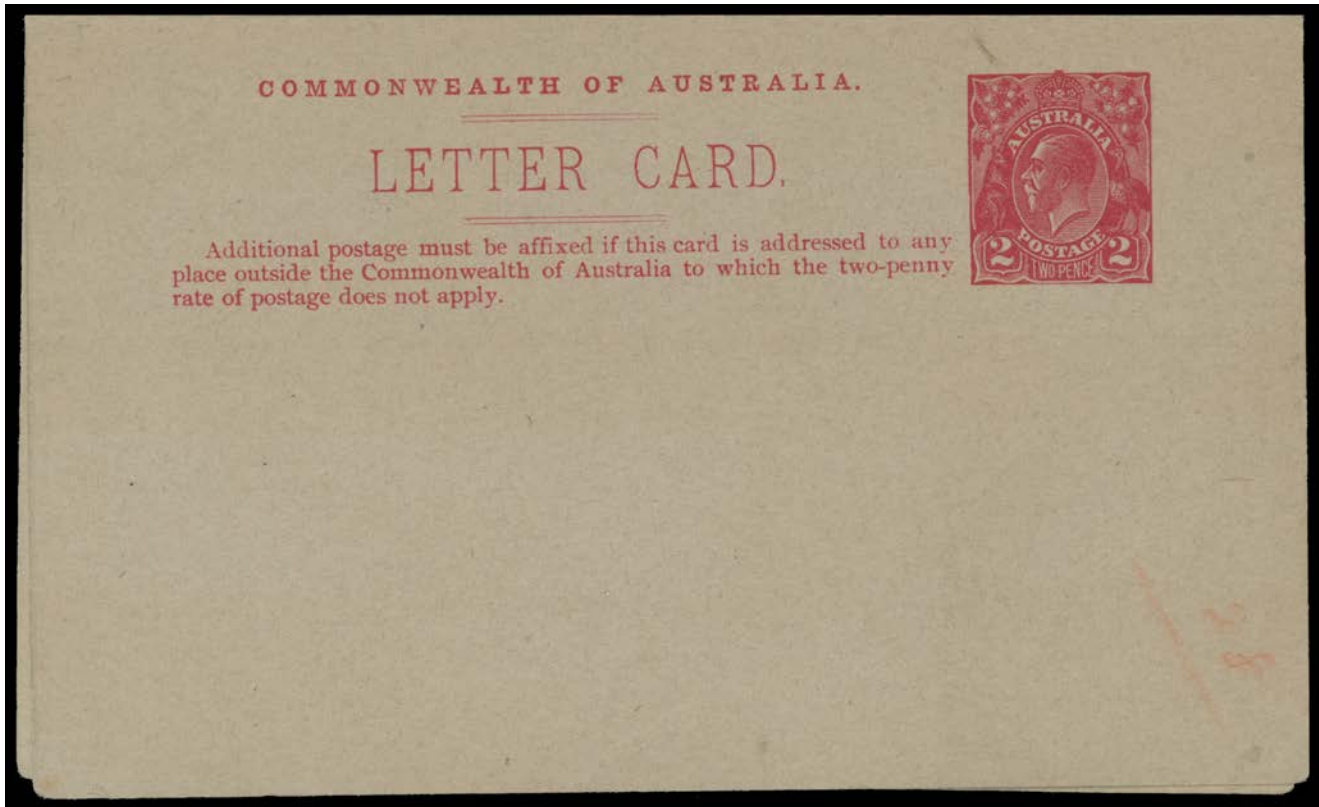

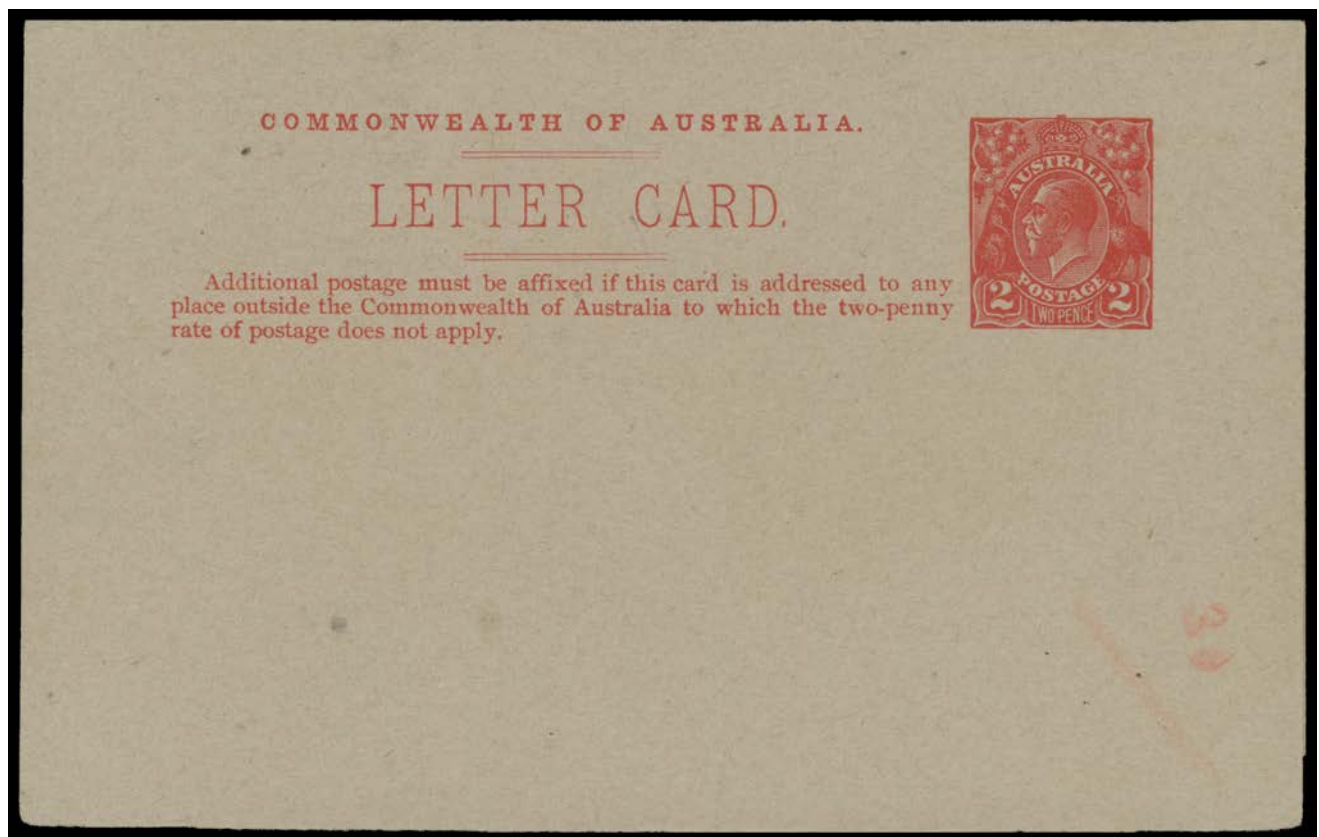

**2246** P A - 'GOVERNMENT HOUSE/SYDNEY NSW' in red-vermillion - close to the issued colour - ACSC #LC49P(1)B, faint "30" in red-pencil at L/R of the address panel, Cat \$7500. [Only two examples, numbered "30" or "31" were prepared]

**2247** PS B **UNIFORM GREY STOCK PERF 12½ ACSC #LC49: 'GOVERNMENT HOUSE/PERTH'** (101x64mm; 'G' 'H' & 'P' larger than other lettering), light bends, 'ORROROO/10C1923/STH AUSTRALIA' cds, Cat \$400. Rare. [Cooke had withdrawn this view in 1912. This substitution by Harrison was the only instance of a 101x64mm view being reinstated]

Terrific traveller's letter headed "Hawker/255 miles north/of Adelaide" states "...We met...23 donks & 4 horses pulling 50 bales of wool = 9 tons...Pichi Richi Pass is...not fit for a big car...but Lizabeth jumps over the gibbers & boulders...".

[The equal-rarest of all the issued views: the ACSC states that "only one used example" is recorded, & no unused examples. Two other examples with 'THREE/HALFPENCE' Surcharge have been noted. A fine used example of 'BURRINJUCK DAM' (In Flood) - of which three examples are known - sold at our auction of 19.5.2018 for \$4600]	4,000
