It hasn't happened often, but on 1.10.1923 the domestic letter rate was REDUCED from 2d to 1½d. Harrison produced the new denomination cards BEFORE he overprinted the 2d remainders.

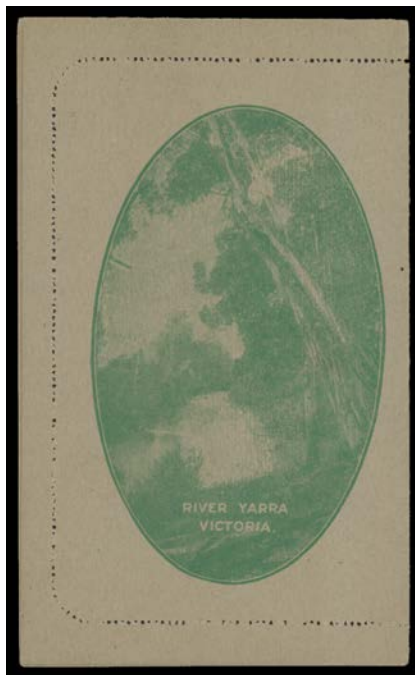
