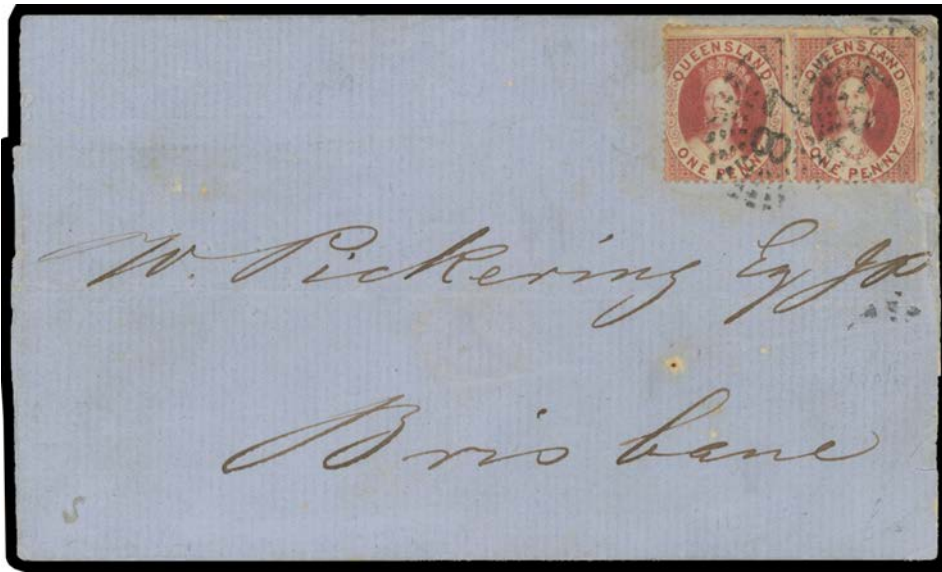

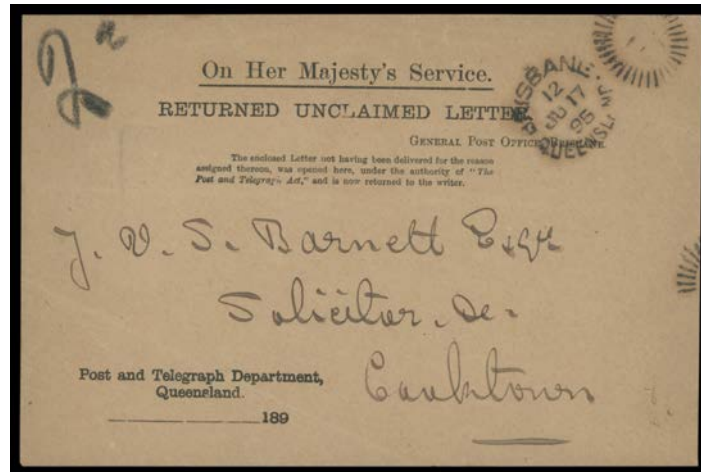

Very attractive. *Ex Richard Stevenson*: acquired at auction in 2003 for SFr2360. [Banana is 590km NW of Brisbane, inland from Bundaberg. The PO opened 1.9.1861. The town was named after a bullock called Banana. The fruit was introduced to northern Queensland from Fiji in the 1870s]
