QUEENSLAND - MORETON BAY DISTRICT

Until 1859, all of what later became Queensland was part of New South Wales. From 1.5.1854, NSW stamps were compulsory for pre-payment of postage. On 10.12.1859, Queensland was proclaimed a separate Colony but continued to use NSW stamps until Queensland stamps were issued on 1.11.1860 & the 'REGISTERED' stamp in -.1.1861. Mail from the so-called "Provisional Period" is very scarce]

540 S B/A+ **Brisbane:** BN '95' on *Laureates* 1d SG 46 (Cat £160), and Rays '95 on superb *Diadems* 1/- SG 99 (Cat £75).

541 S B A2 - 'Q.L'-in-concentric ovals on *Diadem* 2d (full margins, small blemishes).

542 S A A1 **Callandoon:** BN '74' on fine *Sydney Views* 3d SG 39 (Cat £325). Rated RRRR.

200^T**Lot 543**

543 S A B1 - 'CALANDOON/JU3/1859/NSW' (spelling error; one 'L') on very fine *Diadem* 6d.

544 S A **Condamine:** Rays '151' on very fine 1856 *Diadems* 1d orange-vermilion SG 107 pair also with Rays '110' - numerals 5mm high - of Surat (RRRR). Rated RRR. [NB: *Hugh Freeman* records the small Rays '110' only for Ballalaba NSW, which opened 1.4.1861. However, the imperf *Diadems* were issued from 1856 & *Bernie Manning* illustrates usage on a *Diadem* 2d. We are therefore confident of it being originally used at Surat]

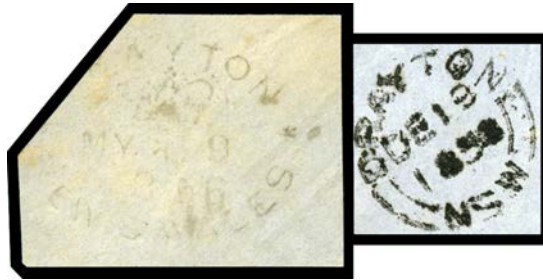

545 S A+ A1 **Drayton:** Rays '86' largely superb strike on superb *Diadems* 6d. *RPSofV Certificate* (1978).

548 C B A1 - Rays '131' on Imperf *Diadems* 1d pair (full margins) on outer to Brisbane, very fine b/s of 'GLADSTONE/SP26/1859/=NSW=', 'MARYBOROUGH/=NSW=', 'GAYNDAH/=NSW=' & 'BRISBANE/OC17/1859/=NSW=', minor blemishes. BN rated RRRR (*Hugh Freeman RRR*).
