1352	C	B	1943 (Apr 16) registered airmail to GB with 2c plus 9c 20c & 30c pairs, very fine strike of the by-now worn 'PASSED BY CENSOR/-----No 2' cachet (#H.IV.2a) in black, minor blemishes. [<i>Hopson & McCloy</i> state at page 54 " Two examples...are recorded ". From July 1942, the airmail rate was reduced to an all-inclusive fee of 1r. This cover may have been carried in a closed bag - which would explain the absence of transit markings - from Seychelles by <i>RAF Catalina</i> that flew to Diego Suarez on 19.4.1943]
