**WESTERN AUSTRALIA - Specimen Stamps**

The Specimen stamps offered by Colony/State represent the largest and most extensive collection to appear at auction since Bill McCredie's collection was sold in 2011. Included are numerous items that were not present in the McCredie sale. NB: in respect of items from archival collections of various UPU members, often these stamps have been soaked and cleaned resulting in some loss of colour. Those with 'ULTRAMAR' handstamp on piece are noted as 'Ex Goa Postal Archives'. Those off-piece are more generically noted as 'Ex Portuguese Colonial Archives'.
