**GERMANY: 1934 LufthansaZeppelin** illustrated cover to Sydney posted on board Norddeutscher Lloyd liner "Europa" with Eagle Airmails 10pf, 15pf & 50pf tied 'DEUTSCH-AMERIKANISCHE-SEEPOST/BREMEN-NEW YORK/9.10.34/ NORDDEUTSCHER/LLOYD/D. EUROPA' ship cancel paying 25pf letter rate plus 50pf airmail surcharge, 'Mit Vorausflug nach Southampton' boxed cachet in pink & 'DEUTSCHER SCHLEUDERFLUG/ 10.OKT.34/[plane & ship]/DAMPFER "EUROPA" - SOUTHAMPTON' h/s in green alongside, sealed with Lufthansa 'REISE IM FLUGZEUG' label, 'KARACHI/CANCELLED' *jusq'ua* cachet applied to airmail etiquettes, minor edge faults & aging marks. Accelerated by catapult-launched aircraft to connect at Southampton with *Imperial Airways* service IE290 terminating at Karachi, India; **extremely rare catapult service mail to Australia.**
