1918 C **NETHERLANDS INDIES: 1931-39** group with variety of frankings including Airmails & Commemoratives noted 1931-32 endorsed for internal NEI airmail then ship to Australia x5 including one further endorsed "From Brisbane by air" paying additional 35c for Australian internal airmail and 1933 endorsed "Via Amsterdam" (b/s) with 'PELIKAAN' cds at 130c rate, 1935 "PER QANTAS LUCHTMAIL" at 105c rate, 1935 registered at 80c rate including Christian Military Home set, 1937-38 postcards to New Zealand with Wilhelmina 12½c single and to Rye (Vic) at 20c rate, 1938 Tea Samples pouch with 'THEE' revenues x3 on back, condition variable. **(16)**
