- 1013** C B - cover to Melbourne endorsed "Registered" & "36" in red with 1/2d pair & 1d strip of 3 all type a tied by 'MANUS/5JL16' cds straight-line 'Passed by Censor/[initials]' on 1916, superb strike of the rare boxed 'Manus' h/s with 'Kaiserliche Station' removed (Powell #83; rated F) on the reverse & Melbourne arrival b/s of 9SE16, minor spotting mostly on the face.
- 1014** CL B - (Aug 22) cover with 'THE TREASURY/RABAU' cachet in violet at L/L, to Melbourne with 5d type c tied by Rabaul cds, German registration label, Melbourne arrival b/s, slightly truncated & opened-out.
