[Although usage to overseas destinations is highly unusual, it seems there was no specific prohibition about using the Charity stamps for that purpose, provided only the notional rate of postage was paid by them] (2)

Used five weeks after issue and correctly rated, making this as close as we have seen to a commercial cover. However, it must be queried if the Charities were available at outback post offices. [Richmond is more than 500km W of Bowen]
